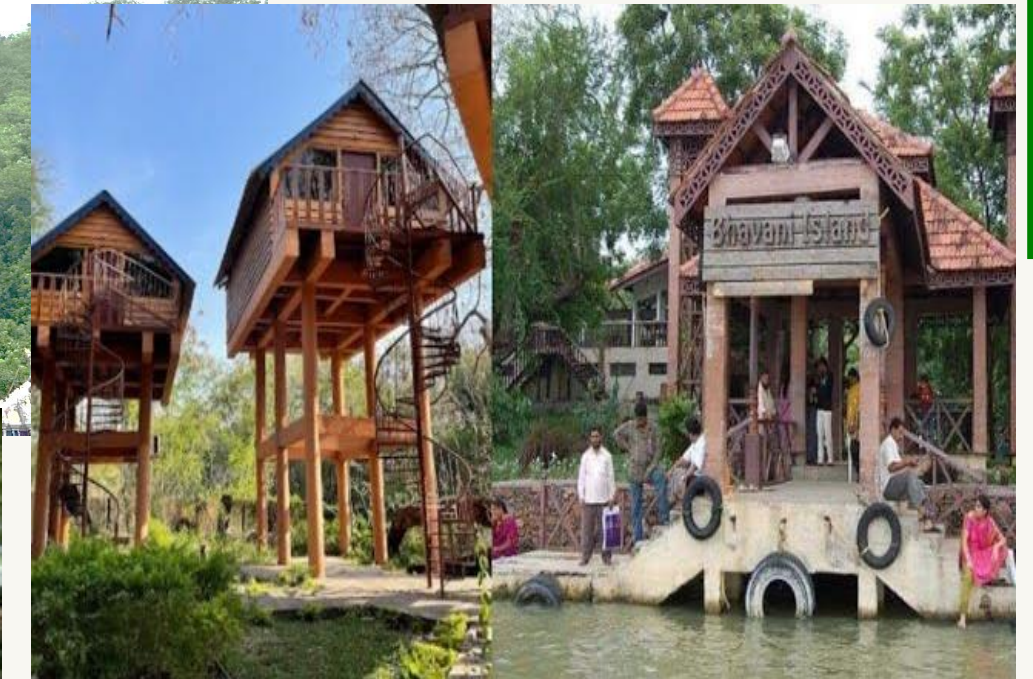

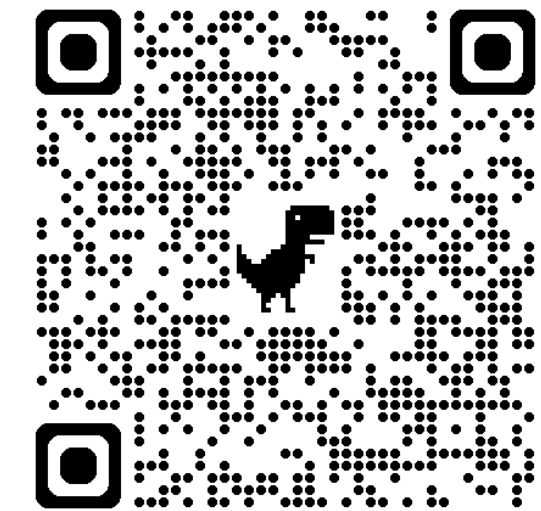

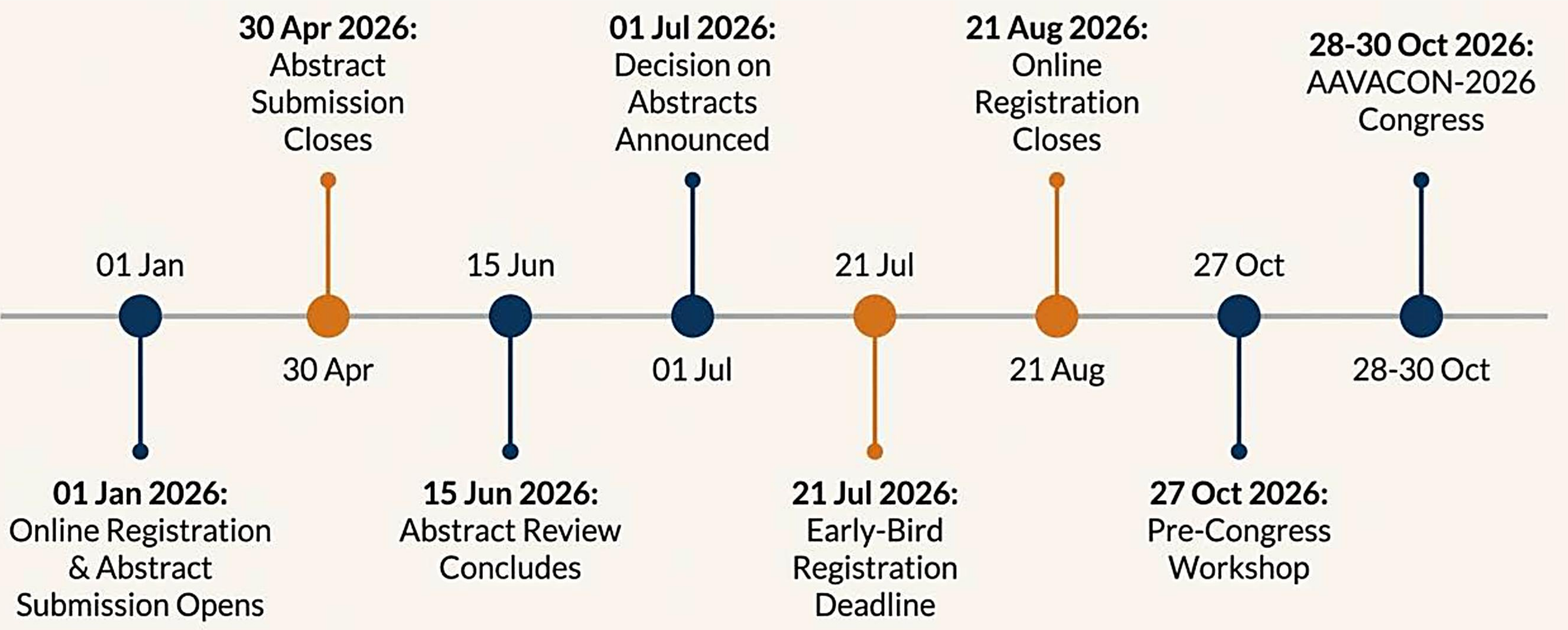

- **Content:** Must include introduction, materials & methods, results & conclusions. No figures, tables, or references in the abstract.
- **Poster Format:** A0 size (~84 × 119 cm), portrait orientation.

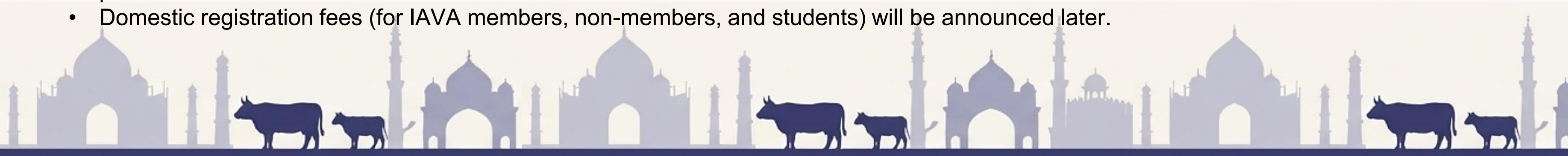
